*Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

*Section 1.* To defray the expenses of the City of Providence for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, the sums of money or so much thereof, as are authorized by law, indicated in the accompanying schedule, are hereby appropriated for the objects and purposes, and in amounts expressed therein provided that payments thereunder shall be subject to the provisions of the Home Rule Charter of 1980, validated by the General Assembly of the State

of Rhode Island at its January Session, A.D., 1981 and approved November 4, 1980, and subject to the provisions of the City Ordinances relative to the expenditures of money from the City Treasury. Fiscal Assistance to State and Local Governments rules and regulations shall govern the portion of this Budget so designated.

*Section 2.* The payments to the School Fund of the following estimated receipts included in the appropriation of \$269,415,988 for the support of the Public Schools for the City of Providence fiscal period 2002-2003, will be increased or decreased to conform with the actual amounts received from such sources during the City of Providence fiscal year 2002-2003.

*Section 3.* Any transfer to the General Fund from Expendable Trust Funds shall be restricted to and deemed to be utilized for the reduction of debt obligations of the City of Providence, as provided for in Section 808 of the Home Rule Charter.

*Section 4.* The provisions included in this ordinance supersede any prior ordinances or any provisions thereof.

*Section 5.* Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 17-185 and Section 17-186 of the Code of Ordinances, the amount of \$27,257,365 is hereby appropriated to the Pension Accumulation Fund, reflecting a 30-year amortization of the pension liability and the third year of a four-year plan to appropriate the actuarial assumption.

*Section 6.* No payments can be made from the general fund to employees that were originally hired under non-local source funds without prior approval from the City Council through an Ordinance.

*Section 7.* This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.

*Section 1.* The afore described Compensation Plan is hereby adopted for all City Officers and employees and shall be applied to each, except as hereinafter provided.

*Section 2.* The salary for each position is categorized as one (1) of sixty-five (65) "Pay Grades", each of which contains five (5) "Steps". The "Pay Grades" and "Steps" are enumerated and set forth in Table I (Grade 1 — Grade 35) and Table II (Grade A1 — Grade A30).

*Section 3.* Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance, any and all employees in the Office of the Mayor shall be excepted from any salary established herein so long as the total of the compensation for such employees does not exceed the annual budget appropriation for personnel services in the office of the Mayor.

*Section 4.* Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Ordinance, the compensation for positions approved by the Salary Review Commission and legal assistants to the City Solicitor shall be no greater than those herein specified; however, any department head or legal assistant to the City Solicitor may be compensated at a rate lower than that established herein, and that lower compensation shall be allowed by this Ordinance.

*Section 5.* Any other provision of this Ordinance notwithstanding Parks Department

employees permanently classified as Laborers and whom as of May 15, 2002 are being compensated out of rank as Equipment Operators are not authorized to continue said out of rank compensation. Should any employee affected by this provision obtain or possess a Commercial Driver's License *within 60 days upon passage of this ordinance* said individual shall be permanently upgraded to the classification of Equipment Operator. The number of increased Equipment Operators will equally decrease the classification of Laborer. No city officer or employee shall authorize any employee to work out of rank when said employee lacks the stated minimum qualifications for the out of rank position.

*Section 6.* Effective with the adoption of this Ordinance, Officers and Employees of the City of Providence may authorize Employees to perform duties of a higher rated classification only when a temporary vacancy exists in the higher rated classification, caused by leave or retirement, and that said position is funded and provided for in this Ordinance. Said assignment may be for a maximum of 30 days per fiscal year. Any and all other assignments of an out of rank nature must be approved by the City Council following petition by the Personnel Director.

*Section 7.* The provisions of this ordinance

shall not be construed as a ratification of any collective bargaining agreement.

*Section 8.* This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

*Section 60.* The number of employees in the Office of the Mayor shall not be limited. The Mayor may appoint without reference to civil service provisions and without the necessity for approval by the City Council a Chief of Staff and such Deputies, Assistant's, Aides, Secretar-

ies, Stenographers, Clerks and other personnel as he may deem necessary.

*Section 61.* No person shall be appointed to, and the City Treasurer shall not pay, nor shall an officer or employee of the city issue a check for the payment of, nor pay any salary or compensations to a person holding or claiming to hold a position in the classified service in any department which is in excess of the total number of funded positions or the number of any individual class of positions provided herein for the particular department; provided, however, that with the approval of the department head and the Director of Finance, said maximum may be exceeded temporarily when regular employees are absent on vacation and the excess employees do not aggregate more than the number on vacation or during the absence of employees, due to injuries received while discharging their duties as employees or during absences of employees or sick leave and it is necessary to employ temporary employees for the duration of the employees sick leave, or during the absence of employees who have been granted a temporary leave of absence or when in the opinion of the Director of Finance, a temporary emergency exists.

*Section 62.* Where no maximum limit is fixed on the total number of positions or the number of any individual class of positions in a department, the number of persons appointed and employees shall be determined by the unexpended appropriation available.

*Section 63.* Chapter 2001-34 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence approved October 29, 2001, with all amendments and additions thereto, is hereby repealed and all other Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are likewise repealed.

*Section 64.* Any other provision of this Ordinance notwithstanding Parks Department employees permanently classified as Laborers

and whom as of May 15, 2002 are being compensated out of rank as Equipment Operators are not authorized to continue said out of rank compensation. Should any employee affected by this provision obtain or possess a Commercial Driver's License *within 60 days upon passage of this ordinance* said individual shall be permanently upgraded to the classification of Equipment Operator. The number of increased Equipment Operators will equally decrease the classification of Laborer. No city officer or employee shall authorize any employee to work out of rank when said employee lacks the stated minimum qualifications for the out of rank position.

*Section 65.* Effective with the adoption of this Ordinance, Officers and Employees of the City of Providence may authorize Employees to perform duties of a higher rated classification only when a temporary vacancy exists in the higher rated classification, caused by leave or retirement, and that said position is funded and provided for in this Ordinance. Said assignment may be for a maximum of 30 days per fiscal year. Any and all other assignments of an out of rank nature must be approved by the City Council following petition by the Personnel Director.

*Section 66.* The provisions of this ordinance

shall not be construed as a ratification of any collective bargaining agreement.

*Section 67.* This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
