WHEREAS, the Providence Redevelopment Agency hereby certifies that the following property consisted of uninhabited boarded up or otherwise uninhabitable buildings and that subject parcel was subject to Eminent Domain proceedings by the Providence Redevelopment Agency, and:

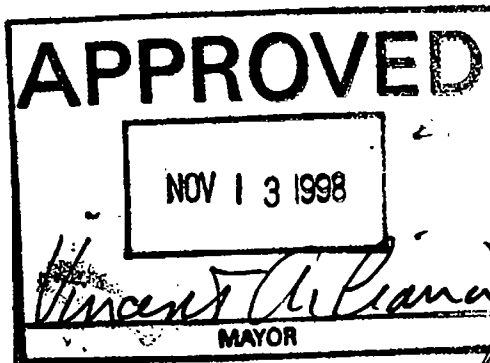
WHEREAS, on April 13, 1998, by Resolution of the Providence Redevelopment Agency did authorize Eminent Domain proceedings of Assessor's Plat 32 Lots 199, 429 and 450, 171-185 Bridgham and 160 Bridgham Street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council does hereby cancel or abate, in whole, the taxes assessed in the amount of Eleven Thousand Nine hundred Ninety and 55/100 Dollars (\$11,990.55), Twenty Five Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Eight and 66/100 Dollars (\$25,558.66) and Sixteen Thousand Four Hundred Forty Seven and 57/100 Dollars (\$16,447.57) upon the above mentioned properties in accordance with Rhode Island General law Section 44-7-23.

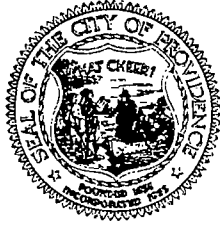

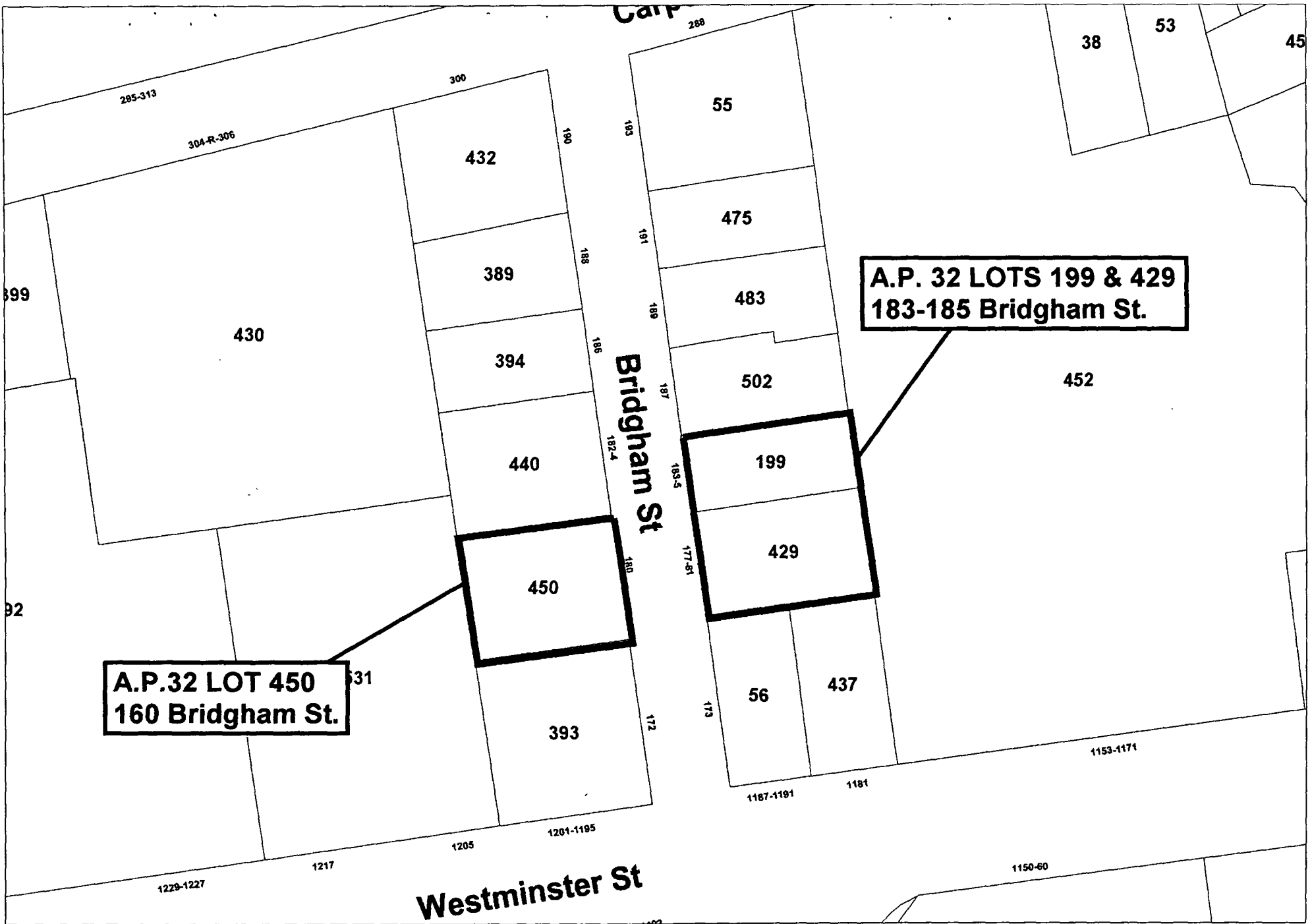
