Specific information is required, including the date interest was acquired, the nature of the interest, contract or ownership, names of partners, associates or family members involved, and the expected duration of the interest.

In the fall of 1983, the RI Department of Education appointed me as Special Education Review Officer to hear appeals of placements of students under the Education for the Handicapped Act. This is a duty which requires review of cases based on the record and briefs, and a written decision. Cases are compensated at \$500 per decision. I have decided one appeal to date and continue to remain on the active list. Because the Human Relations Commission enforces anti-discrimination law in the area of handicapped access to education, I have asked not to be assigned to any cases arising in Providence. Total time expended, after office hours, has amounted to approximately 10 hours. I have offered to submit this question to the State Conflict of Interest Commission, but both the Department of Education and the Human Relations Commission have declined this offer.
