# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 463

Approved August 15, 1981

RESOLVED, That the City of Providence, owner of certain land located in the City of Cranston and laid out and delineated as Lot 17 on Assessor's Plat 34, is hereby authorized to grant an Easement to Greenwood Development Corporation, owner of certain land abutting the said Providence land, which is laid out as Assessor's Lots 2 and 19 on Assessor's Plat 34 of the City of Cranston.

Providence will grant the right of easement for public highway purposes the parcel of land hereinafter described, and that no building to be allowed within the easement.

Description:

Beginning at a granite bound at the northwesterly corner of the herein described parcel on the westerly side of Diane Drive, said bound also being on the northerly line of land now or formerly of the City of Providence; thence running S 55° 45' 34" E a distance of 64.71 (sixty-four and 71/100) feet along the westerly line of Diane Drive to a point on the southerly line of said City of Providence land; thence running N 73° 38' 45" E a distance of 64.71 (sixty-four and 71/100) feet along the southerly line of said City of Providence land to a granite bound on the easterly line of Diane Drive; thence running N 55° 45' 34" W a distance of 64.71 (sixty-four and 71/100) feet along the easterly line of Diane Drive to a point on the northerly line of said City of Providence land; thence running S 73° 38' 45" a distance of 64.71 (sixty-four and 71/100) feet along the northerly line of said City of Providence land to the point or place of beginning. The above described parcel has an area of 3236 square feet.

GRANT OF EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the CITY OF PROVIDENCE, a municipal corporation created by the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island, hereby grants to the CITY OF CRANSTON, a municipal corporation located in the State of Rhode Island and organized under, and by virtue of the laws of the State of Rhode Island, its successors and assigns, with QUIT-CLAIM COVENANTS, the right of easement to use for public highway purposes the parcel of land hereinafter described.

The GRANTOR hereby covenants and agrees for itself, its successors and assigns, with said CITY OF CRANSTON, its successors and assigns, that it will not build or erect any permanent building or structure of any kind under, over or upon the hereinafter described premises.

DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF EASEMENT

Beginning at a granite bound at the northwesterly corner of the herein described parcel on the westerly side of Diane Drive, said bound also being on the northerly line of land now or formerly of the City of Providence; thence running S 55° 45' 34" E a distance of 64.71 (sixty-four and 71/100) feet along the westerly line of Diane Drive to a point on the southerly line of said City of Providence land; thence running N 73° 38' 45" E a distance of 64.71 (sixty-four and 71/100) feet along the southerly line of said City of Providence land to a granite bound on the easterly line of Diane Drive; thence running N 55° 45' 34" W a distance of 64.71 (sixty-four and 71/100) feet along the easterly line of Diane Drive to a point on the northerly line of said City of Providence land; thence running S 73° 38' 45" W a distance of 64.71 (sixty-four and 71/100) feet along the northerly line of said City of Providence land to the point or place of beginning. The above described parcel has an area of 3236 square feet.

Meaning and intending to describe the new "roadway easement" by the City of Providence to the City of Cranston as shown on the plat entitled, "RIDGWOOD SECTION 1 IN CRANSTON RHODE ISLAND GREENWOOD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION PETER ALVITI JR. P.E. - CIVIL ENGINEERS - MARCH 1981".


This Department has reviewed the subject referral which contained a request by Greenwood Development Corporation for the granting of an easement for public highway purposes on City property in Cranston and delineated as Lot 17 on Assessor's Plat 34 of the City of Cranston. This Department also field checked the information contained therein, and reports as follows:

A field inspection revealed that Lot 17 and another City owned lot (Lot 24) are located at Pippin Orchard Road in Cranston. These lots are unimproved woodland and inaccessible by foot or motor vehicle. It appeared that portion of the waterline which runs from Scituate Reservoir to the City is located under those lots. Based on the Assessor's Plat map Greenwood Development Corporation's property is subdivided into 20 parcels by Diane Drive which is not existed at the present. This 50' wide road is to be built from Pippin Orchard Road across Lot 17, property of the City of Providence. The area in question contains 3,236 sq. ft. (approx. 50' x 65').

From the planning point of view, this Department has no objection to this petition.

Enclosed with this letter for your information file is a copy of a map of the area in question as outlined in red color. My staff and I are available at your pleasure to review this matter with the Committee members.
