FIRE MARSHALL OF THE PROVIDENCE FIRE DEPT.CLASS TITLE:

FIRE MARSHALL

CLASS DEFINITION:

Direct supervision, control and management of the activities of the Fire Prevention Bureau and its employees, in accordance with the laws, ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Providence, and The Providence Fire Dept.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES
OF WORK:

Work involves the responsibility for scheduling, assigning and supervising the work of all personnel of the Fire-Prevention Bureau in both general and specialized fields. Said assignments include the field of inspection, fire investigations, and the related activities of the Arson Squad; a Fire Safety Education Program, a testing program as it relates to the fire safety of various products; a Bureau of Photography, the surveillance and control of fire safety factors in new construction, public relations; and maintenance of all department records and statistics.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES
OF WORK:

To organize and direct an effective Fire Safety Program encompassing all aspects of Fire Prevention. Said program to include an effective inspection program of buildings within the City of Providence in accordance with ordinances and provisions setting up and regulating the Fire Prevention Bureau. To supervise a Fire Investigation Program including accidental fires, and incendiary fires, falling into the classification of statutory burning and/or arson. To maintain a careful surveillance of all new construction as submitted by plan or blueprint, and through inspection, in so far as they relate to fixed or manual fire protection, exits, and means of egress thereto, and all fire safety features involved. To organize and supervise a demolition program, in close association with other city agencies, to the end, that all buildings construed to be a life or fire hazard will be rehabilitated or razed. To conduct a Fire Safety Education Program in all educational institutions, Hospitals, and related institutions, Business and industrial establishments and with the public in general, utilizing all possible media of contact. Where pertinent or needed, said program will include fire brigade training and evacuation procedures. To protect the public through a testing program involving the fire safety of products as it may relate to their flame spread rate, etc. To insure the careful maintenance of Fire Dept. records and statistics. To supervise the operation of a Photography Bureau as it may relate to any or all of the above programs.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGE,
ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

Ability to plan, assign and supervise the work of subordinates. The ability to read and interpret plans, specifications and blueprints. The ability to express oneself clearly and concisely orally, including the field of public speaking, and in writing.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGE
ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

The ability to conduct a thorough and effective inspection of buildings based on experience and knowledge. The ability and experience to ascertain the area of origin, and probable cause of a fire, in the knowledge that both are essential to the successful conclusion of an investigation. The ability to deal with people as it may be reflected in the correction of complaints, the training of personnel in hospitals, institutions and from the fields of business and industry in fire brigade training, fire safety education and in the field of public relations.

A thorough knowledge of fire prevention practices and related subject matters.

The ability to handle and work with audio-visual equipment,

FOR APPOINTMENT:

Extensive experience in the field, in all aspects of fire safety, and the capability of directing and supervising personnel in the various facets of an effective fire - prevention program.

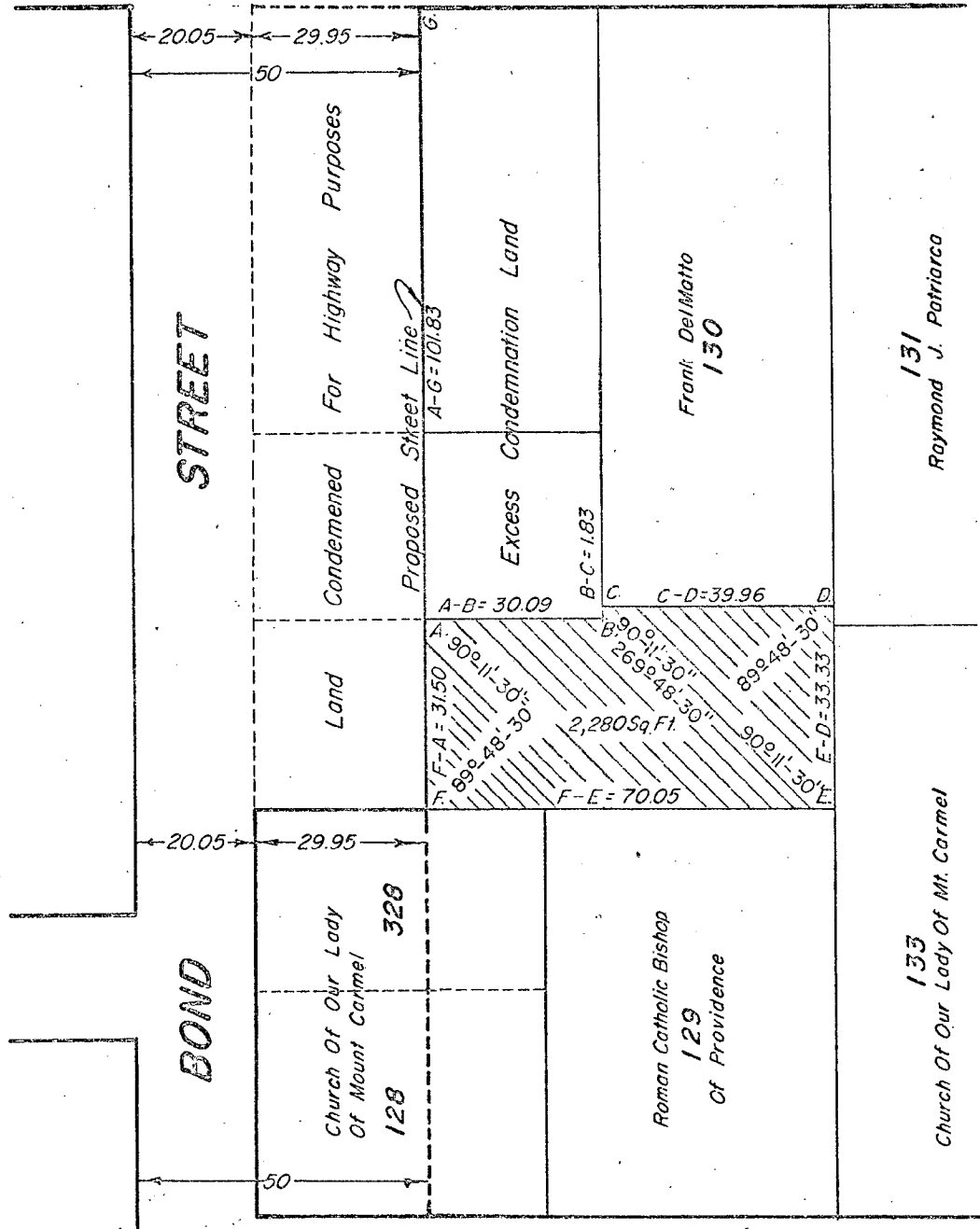
