I respectfully request that you prepare, and have submitted to the City Council by Majority Leader Thomas M. Glavin by request, an amendment to the current compensation ordinance making the following salary changes, effective January 1, 1985:

Commissioner of Public Safety:

from \$43,334.20 to \$52,000.00

At its September 25, 1984 meeting, the Salary Review Commission established a \$55,000.00 maximum salary for this position, effective January 1, 1985, with which I concur;

Director of Public Works:

from \$37,500.00 to \$48,000

The Salary Review Commission established a \$52,500.00 cap for this position, with which I concur;

Deputy Director of Public Works and City Engineer:

from \$29,424.72 to \$35,000.00

Chief of the Division of Purchasing:

from Grade 27 to \$40,000.00

Director of the Department of Inspection and Standards:

from \$38,000.00 to \$45,000.00

The Salary Review Commission established a \$50,000.00 cap for this position, with which I concur;

Director of the Department of Public Property:

from \$37,000.00 to \$45,000.00

from \$45,474.52 to \$48,000.00

Recorder of Deeds:

from \$23,539.00 to \$30,000.00

The Salary Review Commission established a \$30,000.00 cap for this position, with which I concur;

Director of Personnel:


from \$35,310.08 to \$40,000.00

The Salary Review Commission established a \$50,000.00 cap for this position. I recommend this cap be set at \$45,000.00;

Deputy Director of Personnel and Assistant to the Mayor for Personnel:

I would like this position retitled Deputy Director of Personnel for Labor Relations, and the salary increased from \$32,955.52 to \$35,000.00.
