No. 575 **AN ORDINANCE** REQUIRED THAT ALL BIDDERS BE CURRENT WITH ALL CITY OF PROVIDENCE TAXES IN ORDER TO BE QUALIFIED BIDDERS FOR LEASES AND CONTRACTS FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, AS AMENDED.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 21-28.1 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, entitled: "Article II. Contract, Purchases and Sales" is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Insert in subsection (a) Line 6, after the word "services", No contract shall be awarded to any party who is not current with all taxes which have been levied against that party by the City of Providence. These taxes shall include, but not be limited to property, excise and tangible taxes; provided, however, that this Section shall not apply to any party who has disputed its taxes in the manner provided by law by the State of Rhode Island, nor to any party who, while delinquent, has entered into an agreement with the City Collector for the payment of its taxes and is current in that agreement.

All bidders shall obtain from the collector of taxes a certificate of its status with respect to taxes and shall submit the same with each bid.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
