No. 679 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1981-39, EFFECTIVE JULY 20, 1981, BY CREATING TWO NEW DIVISIONS WITHIN SECTION 4, BUILDING CODE AND INSPECTION AND TRANSFERRING CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY WITHIN THAT DEPARTMENT.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1981-39 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence effective July 20, 1981, entitled: "An Ordinance Making an Appropriation of One Hundred Forty Nine Million, Eight Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars and Nine Cents (\$149,862,122.09) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1982 as amended is hereby amended by transferring certain sums of money within Section 4, Building Codes and Inspection, as follows:
