No. 244 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT BUDGET FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2024-2025 AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING & HUMAN SERVICES TO SUBMIT THE CDBG, HOME, ESG AND HOPWA BUDGET AND APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT






