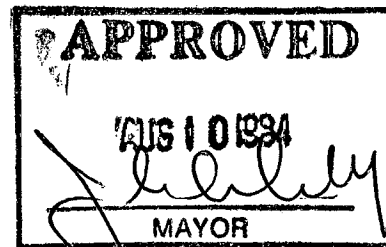
RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

This letter is to formally request permission to have the portion of Westminster Street between Hospital Trust Plaza and Dorrance Street closed to traffic on Wednesday, September 12, 1984 (raindate Thursday, September 13) between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. for the United Way Campaign's kick-off event, Care Fair '84.


Based on our conversation, it is my understanding that you will initiate passage of a resolution to close the street on that date. It is also my understanding that you will make the initial contact with the downtown merchants and any city departments that will either be affected by or involved with this event.

At this point, RIPTA has been contacted and has agreed to reroute the buses during Care Fair. Arrangements have also been made with the Providence Police Department to have two officers on duty.

I ask for your additional assistance and guidance in obtaining access to electricity. Last year it was necessary to install and connect ten weather-proof 2-circuit panels and two 20-amp ground fault breakers in each panel. I hope the city can advise us in arranging a similar set-up which is both safe and low-cost.

Thank you for the cooperation you have already provided us. I look forward to working with you toward making Care Fair '84 a successful event.
