The President and all Vice Presidents shall each have authority to sign such instruments, the Vice Presidents to have such authority whether the President be absent or incapacitated or not, and all Secretaries and Assistant Secretaries shall each have authority to seal and attest such instruments.

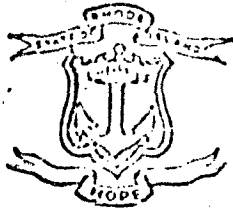
