

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 556

Approved October 10, 1991

WHEREAS, On August 3, 1991 at approximately 1900 hours (7:00 o'clock P.M.) Members of the Neighborhood Response Team Unit of the Providence Police Department along with members of the North Providence Police Department, due to the numerous complaints of burglaries in the area of the North Providence and Providence line, took up a surveillance on a subject known to police, and

WHEREAS, Due to the fact that these breaks that were occurring were done in the exact manner which the subject had previously been arrested for, and

WHEREAS, The Police did observe the subject after watching him drive through the Windmill Street area several times, and

WHEREAS, The subject did park his vehicle on Charles Street and did exit the said vehicle carrying a black bag, and

WHEREAS, Because of the subjects' past criminal history, police suspected that he was carrying burglary tools, and

WHEREAS, About approximately one hour later police observed the subject walking back to the vehicle, which was under surveillance carrying a large black bag which was quite different from the one he had been carrying, and

WHEREAS, Upon reaching his vehicle, the subject opened the passenger side door and placed the large bag on the seat and then got into the vehicle, and

WHEREAS, The subject pulled off in his vehicle and a short distance down the street was boxed in by both Departments, and

WHEREAS, When the suspect was apprehended, police noticed that the bag he was carrying had an abundance of assorted jewelry and other items, and

WHEREAS, After further investigation the suspect was arrested and charged with burglary and possession of burglary tools, and

WHEREAS, With the apprehension, it is believed that the subject was responsible for a number of breaks in both communities,


