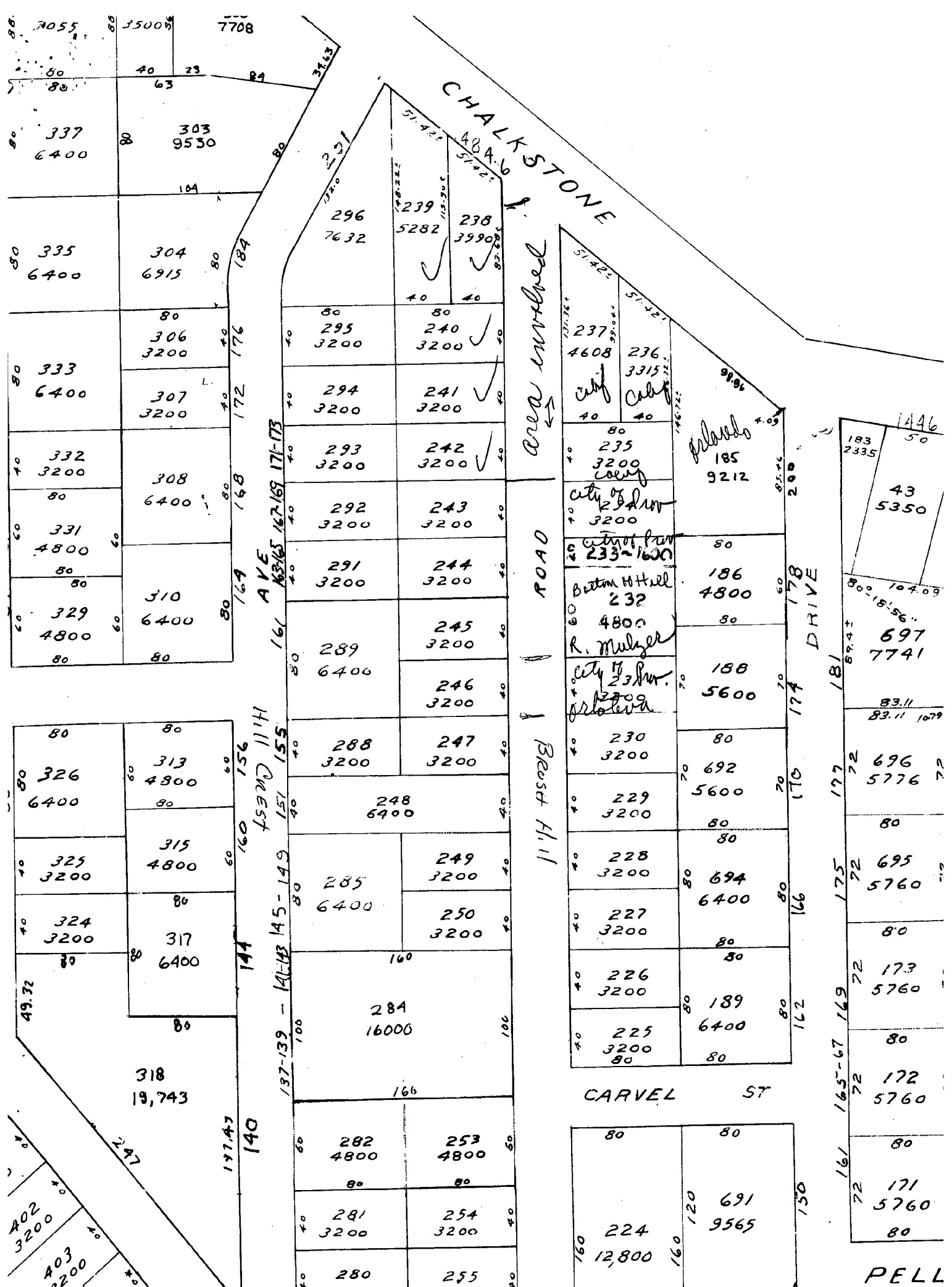
Request: To abandon a portion of Brush Hill Road.

Gentlemen:

The subject referral was presented to the City Plan Commission at its December 7, 1983 meeting.

The City Plan Commission did not vote on this referral due to lack of a quorum, however this Department has reviewed the subject referral.

A communication was received from the Committee on Public Works dated November 22, 1983 regarding the abandonment of that northern portion of Brush Hill Road, facing Chalkstone Avenue and adjacent to Lots 238, 240, 241 and 242 on its westerly side and Lots 237 and 235 on its easterly side on A.P. 94.

The petitioner is John Garabedian of 1486 Chalkstone Avenue, Providence, R.I., who owns aforesaid lots 238, 239, 240, 241 and 242 on AP 94.

The field inspection revealed that Brush Hill Road from Ada Avenue to Chalkstone Avenue is a paper street. The street and surrounding lots are composed of rock out-croppings and ledge with steep slopes of up to 45°. All vacant areas are overgrown with heavy brush and woods, and are covered with rocks. The surrounding streets: Hillcrest Avenue and Ortoleva Drive, contain mostly one-family residential structures.

The office research revealed that Lots 235, 236 and 237 on A.P. 94 are owned by Amelia E. DiJeser of 1156 Las Pulgas Place, Pacific Palisades, CA. This person also owns Lots 243, 228, 227, 226 and 225 on A.P. 94.


Further research revealed ten different ownerships of the lots abutting that portion of Brush Hill Road from Chalkstone Avenue to Carvel Street (also a paper street).

Some of those lots would be landlocked if Brush Hill Road were to be abandoned. Even though there is little likelihood of paving the subject street, property owners would lose a legal right-of-way and render their land worthless.

Therefore, this Department recommends to the Committee on Public Works that this petition be denied.
