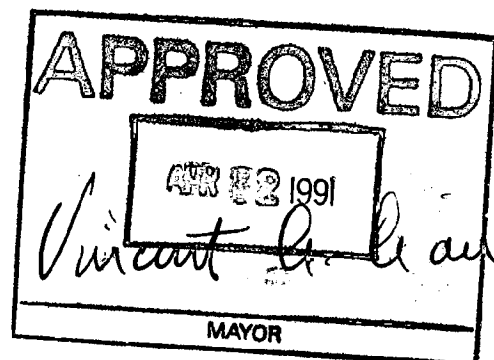
WHEREAS, Aaron J. Oster was born on January 20, 1900 and moved to our capital city where he founded A. J. Oster Company at 50 Sims Street; and
