

I am writing in response to your letter dated May 22, 2006 regarding the petition to the City Council requesting that "**Park Row West**" be re-named to "**Finance Way**" from the point of Francis Street to Exchange Street.

We do have concerns with this street name change request for the following reasons:

- On September 29, 2000 resolution 647 changed a building address in the city of Providence to Financial Plaza. This may cause confusion to the general public because of the like named streets.
- If this change just refers to the single building housing the Bella Vista restaurant – that building was already renamed in March 24, 2003, resolution 151. It is detrimental to everyone involved, including 911 services to continually change the address of a single building.
- The scope of this change because there is a large apartment building at 50 Park Row West and if that building is part of the change this will be a significant impact to both the Postal Service and the occupants of that building.
