No. 430 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS

in the SUM OF TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$2,500,000.00 DOLLARS TO BE USED TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES AND PROVISIONS OF THE REDEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1956.

Approved October 7, 1960

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The City of Providence will issue bonds of said City in the sum of TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$2,500,000.00) DOLLARS designated as "Redevelopment and Slum Clearance Bonds II", under and by virtue of the authority granted by Chapter 3654 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island, as passed by the General Assembly at its January Session, A.D. 1956, and approved April 2, 1956, said act being known as the "Redevelopment Act of 1956".

SEC. 2. The City Treasurer with the advice and consent of the Committee on Finance, and subject to the approval of the Mayor, shall sell and dispose of such bonds at not less than par and accrued interest, if any, and issue said bonds or cause them to be issued under the corporate name and seal of the City of Providence, and when issued, shall receive the proceeds from such sale, and the full amount of such proceeds except premiums, if any, shall be used to effectuate the purposes and provisions of said Redevelopment Act of 1956.

SEC. 3. The bonds shall bear such date in the period beginning October 15, 1960 and ending March 1, 1961 as the City Treasurer, with the approval of the Finance Committee of the City Council, shall determine, and shall be payable in subsequent years, commencing four years after the date of said bonds as follows:

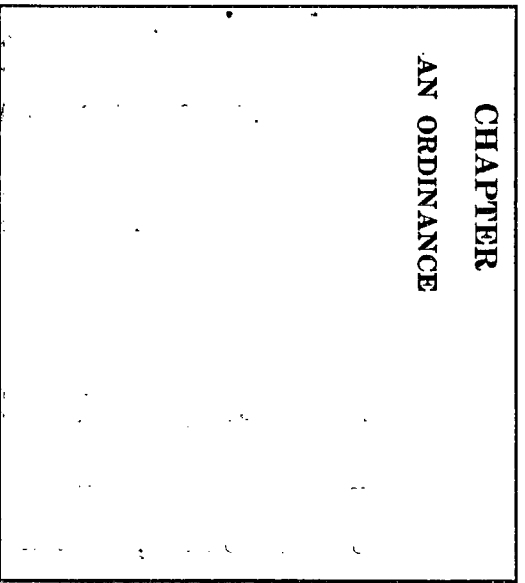

Coupon bonds may be registered as to principal only or may be exchanged in aggregate amounts of \$25,000., or any multiple thereof having the same maturity date, for bonds registered as to both principal and interest in the denomination of \$25,000 or \$100,000. payable at the office of the City Treasurer. Bonds registered as to both principal and interest shall be exchangeable for coupon bonds payable to bearer in the denomination of \$1,000.

Sec. 6. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Treasurer to use forms of bonds substantially the same as the forms approved by the City Council Resolution No. 312, approved July 8, 1960, and hereby approves said forms of bonds for use in connection with the bonds authorized by this Ordinance.

Sec. 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. It is ordained that the Finance Director of the City of Providence be authorized and directed to allow the Commissioner of Public Safety of the City of Providence to submit emergency payrolls for certain personnel of the Police and Fire Departments who are not normally entitled to overtime pay and who have performed unusual additional hours of work during the recent hurricane of September 12, 1960. The names of the employees shall be submitted to the Finance Director for approval. Each such employee so certified and approved shall be entitled to one day's compensation. In the case of salaried employees a day's pay shall be determined as one-fifth of the normal weekly salary. In the case of employees paid at an hourly rate, a day's pay shall be determined as eight hours.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and for the purposes of this ordinance the provisions of Chapter 1290 of the Ordinances of 1959 entitled "An Ordinance Establishing a Compensation Plan for the City of Providence" etc. are hereby waived.
