

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 447

Approved September 9, 1974

RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor, be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a lease with the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations Board of Regents for Education for the rental of the premises located at the Rhode Island School for the Deaf, 530 Hope Street, Providence, Rhode Island, said premises include approximately 5,000 square feet of floor space, consisting of three levels in the west wings of the building heretobefore mentioned.

The rental period of the lease will run for a term of one year, commencing on or about July 1, 1974 and terminating on June 30, 1975; the rental is TWENTY-FOUR HUNDRED (\$2400) DOLLARS per year, payable in equal monthly payments of TWO HUNDRED (\$200) DOLLARS on the first business day of each month, beginning with a payment on or about the first day of July, 1974; this lease shall contain further terms and conditions as may be approved by His Honor the Mayor or the City Solicitor.
