

No. 412

RESOLUTION changing the name of the Nelson Street Elementary School to the Robert F. Kennedy Elementary School.

PRESENTED BY The Chairman on Behalf of the School Committee

RESOLVED, That the members of the Providence School Committee hereby officially change the name of the Nelson Street Elementary School to the Robert F. Kennedy Elementary School in memory of the late Senator Robert F. Kennedy, who in his short life had achieved international prominence as a conscientious, dedicated, devoted public servant while he served his country as United States Attorney General, as United States Senator from the State of New York, and finally as a candidate for the office of President of the United States. It was during this campaign that he met his tragic death at the hands of an assassin. May his philosophy for living be made part of all our lives; he saw wrong and tried to right it, he saw suffering and tried to heal it, and in his own words he stated many times: "Some men see things as they are and say: 'Why?' I dream things that never were and say: "'Why not?'"

For the fortunate among us there is the temptation to follow the easy and familiar path of personal ambition and financial success for those who enjoy the privilege of education, but he was only too well aware of the danger and uncertainty of the times and he chose to blend vision, reason and courage in a personal commitment to the ideals of our American society; and

FURTHER, We wish to express to his wife, Mrs. Robert F. Kennedy, his children, and the Kennedy family our profound sympathy in this hour of deep sorrow.

At a meeting of the School Committee held on  
June 17, 1968 the following resolution was adopted:

Resolution 436

RESOLUTION requesting the Mayor of the City of Providence to  
have an addition built onto the Windmill Street School.

RESOLVED, That the School Committee respectfully requests the  
Mayor of the City of Providence to have an addition built onto  
the Windmill Street School for the purpose of a cafeteria, at  
a cost of approximately \$250,000.00.



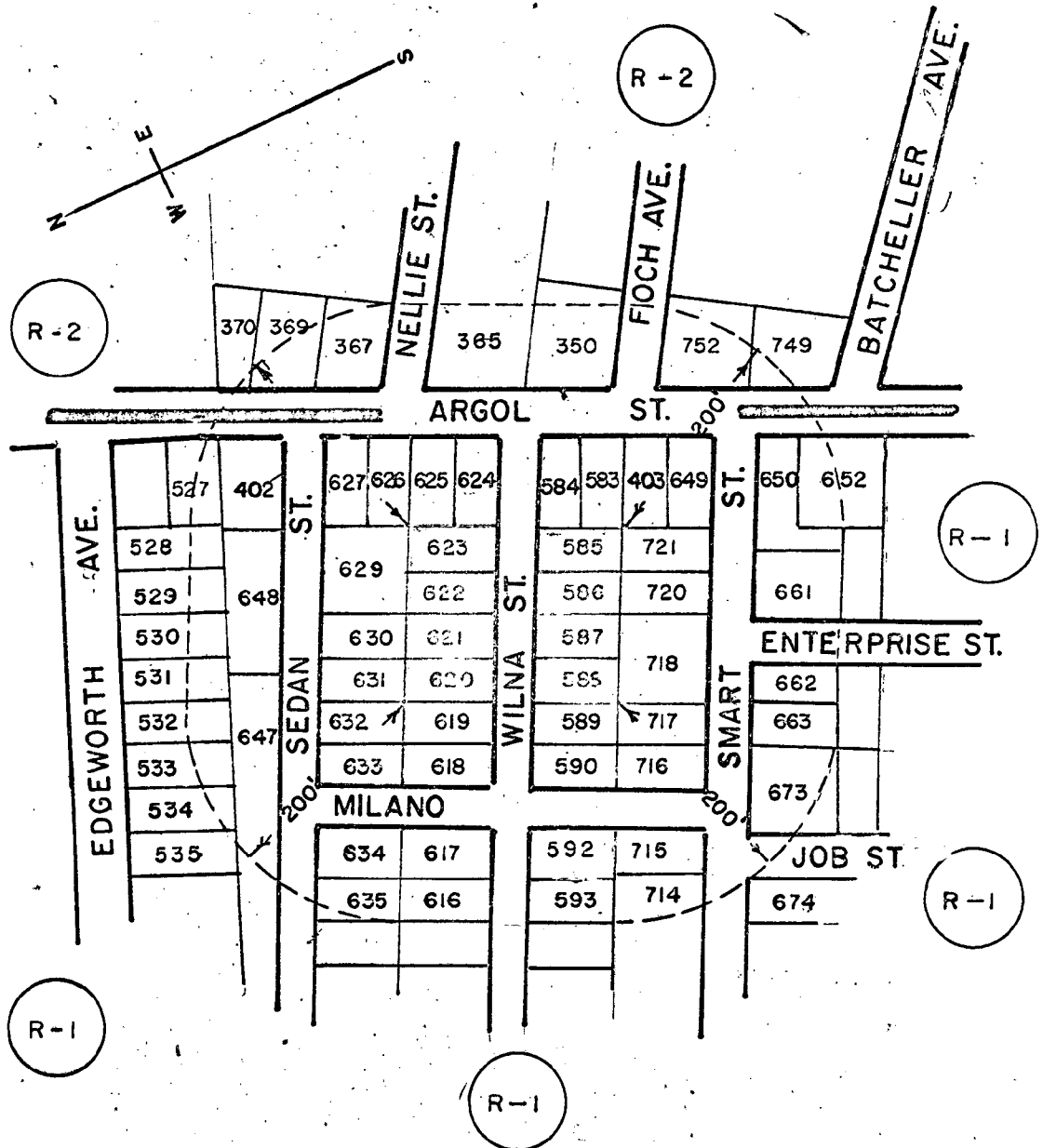
