No. 260 **AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT BUDGET FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2023-2024 AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT TO SUBMIT THE CDBG, HOME, ESG AND HOPWA BUDGET AND APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT**
