

Margaret and Frank Bianco are to celebrate 50 years residence at 20 Champlain Place. They are, respectively, 81 and 90 years of age. Recently they celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary.

I am so fortunate to have them as parents - there being four children; Alice, Gloria, Frank, Jr. and myself - eleven grandchildren, and several great grandchildren. My father, Frank, was employed by the city for 25 yrs in the Sanitation Dept... and my mom, Margaret, raised us four children at this home.

A petition requesting this renaming was circulated amongst the tenants and property owners (there being six dwellings). Each and everyone of them not only supported this request, but felt enthusiastic about it... commenting that the Bianco family had always been such good neighbors, helped stabilize the street, and always kept their home and yard in excellent condition.
