**Request:** That the Traffic Engineer is requested to invoke NO PARKING TO CORNER regulations signs along both sides of Oppor Street at Paul Street.

**Disposition:** An investigator from this department will survey the situation at this location. There is a City Ordinance that prohibits parking within 25 feet of any intersection. Signs do not have to be present in order for a vehicle parked illegally to be tagged.

**Request:** That Foch Avenue, from Argol Street to Silver Spring Street, in an easterly direction, is established as a one way street.

**Disposition:** A traffic survey will be undertaken to determine the feasibility of establishing Foch Avenue as a one way street.

**Request:** That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause Victoria Street and Galileo Avenue as one way streets.

**Disposition:** A survey taken by this department showed that there are no warrants for the establishment of a one way traffic pattern along these two streets.

**Request:** That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause NO PARKING 8AM to 1PM WEEKDAYS along both sides of Early Street, between Broad Street and Cadillac Drive.

**Disposition:** A survey will be undertaken to determine the warrants necessary for prohibiting parking along Early Street during certain hours of the day. However, if this regulation is granted the hours of limitation will be either between 8AM and 10AM or 8AM and 6PM, which are our standard signs.


**Request:** That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of NO THRU TRUCKING signs to be erected along Dove Street at its intersection with John Street and Transit Street.

**Disposition:** Granted. A Traffic Regulation will be issued establishing a NO THRU TRUCKING restriction along Dove Street between John Street and Trnsnit Street.

**Request:** That Weeden Street be made one way running from Federal Street to Atwells Avenue.

**Disposition:** No objection. Once a signed resolution is received by this department, a Traffic Regulation will be issued to establish Weeden Street as a one way street.
