WHEREAS, The recent Journal-Bulletin investigation of the manner in which Section 8 Program funding is developed and allocated in the State of Rhode Island has indicated a need for further investigation, and

WHEREAS, The Governor base called for a further investigation by the Attorney General's Department, and

WHEREAS, The Attorney General has stated his intention of pursuing such investigation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence endorses said investigation and encourages the Attorney General to proceed expeditiously to investigate this matter fully and to bring about prosecution of any illegalities in connection with the administration of the Section 8 Program.
