**No. 365 AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 8, SEC. 8-6 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND, APPROVED AUGUST 8, 1973 AS AMENDED ENTITLED: "DAYS OF HOLDING COURT FOR TRANSACTION OF PROBATE BUSINESS".

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Section 8-6 of Chapter 8 entitled: "Courts" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, adopted August 8, 1973, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Section 8-6. "Days for Holding Court for Transaction of Probate Business".

For the transaction of Probate business, or business to be done by a Court of Probate only, the Judge of the Probate Court shall hold said Court on Tuesday and Thursday of each week; provided that in the months of July and August in each year, the regular sessions of said Court shall be held on the second and fourth Tuesdays and on the Thursdays next following said second and fourth Tuesdays in said months; and provided also, that whenever any such day is a legal holiday then said Court shall be held on the day next following.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

Dear Mr. Clements:

Enclosed is a proposed amendment to §8-6 of Chapter 8. Specifically, under the current §8-6 entitled "Days for Holding Court for Transaction of Probate Business".

The Probate Court's summer schedule calls for Court days during the months of July and August to be held on the second and fourth Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

The proposed amendment seeks to have Court days for the months of July and August to be held on the second and fourth Tuesdays and Thursdays. In sum, the amendment changes the Wednesday Court day to a Thursday Court day for the summer months of July and August.

The reasoning for this amendment would be to provide a year long continuity to the Court's schedule. As you know the Court sits on Tuesdays and Thursdays for the remaining ten months. Additionally, Court personnel would work more efficiently under a set schedule of Tuesdays and Thursdays.

I would appreciate your placing this matter down for the next docket.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:**

**Section 1:**

**Section 8-6 of Chapter 8 entitled "Courts" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, adopted August 8, 1973, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:**

**Section 8-6. "Days for Holding Court for Transaction of Probate Business".**

**For the transaction of Probate business, or business to be done by a Court of Probate only, the Judge of the Probate Court shall hold said Court on Tuesday and Thursday of each week; provided that in the months of July and August in each year, the regular sessions of said Court shall be held on the second and fourth Tuesdays and on the Thursdays next following said second and fourth Tuesdays in said months; and provided also, that whenever any such day is a legal holiday then said Court shall be held on the day next following.**

**Section 2:**
