


Dear Sir:

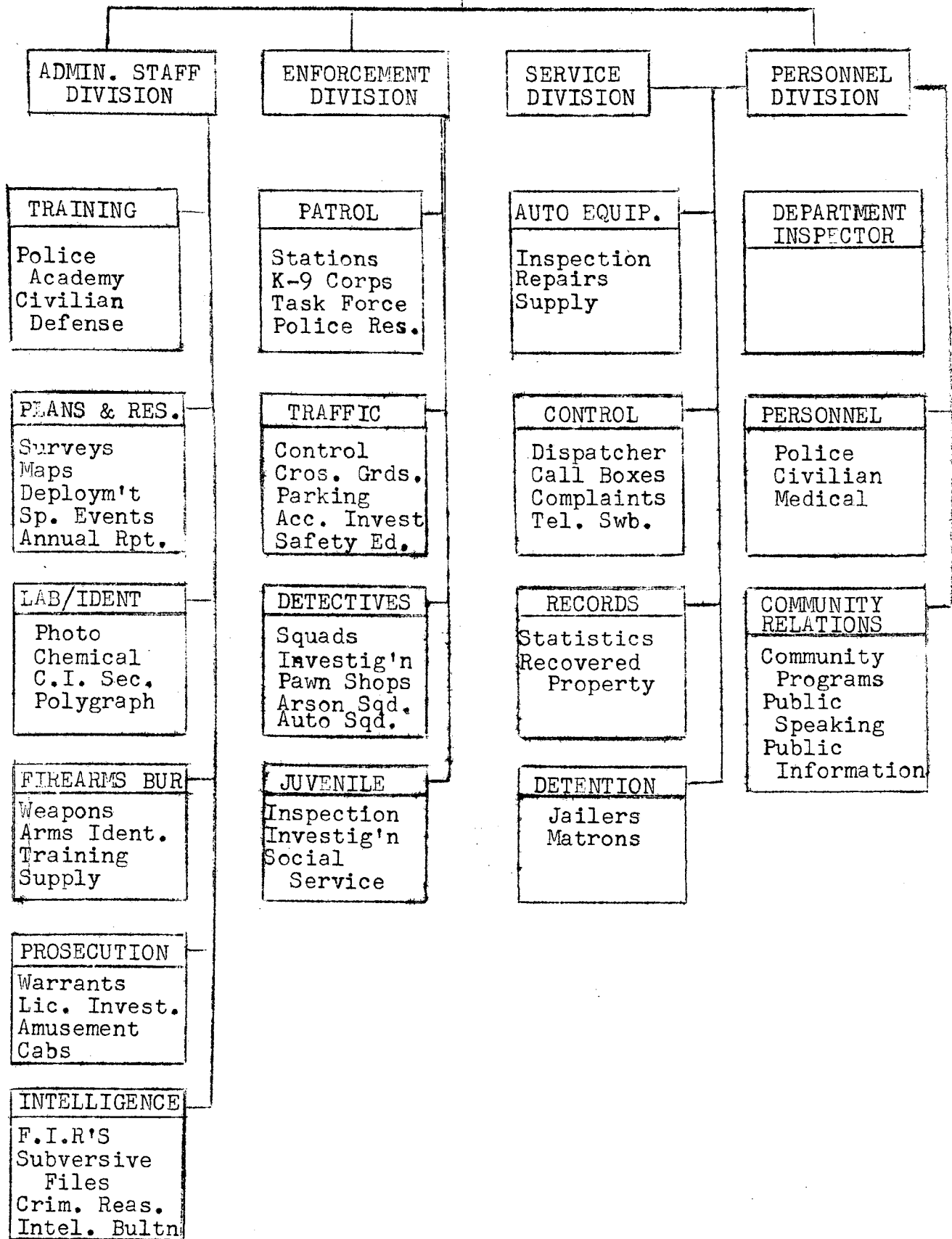

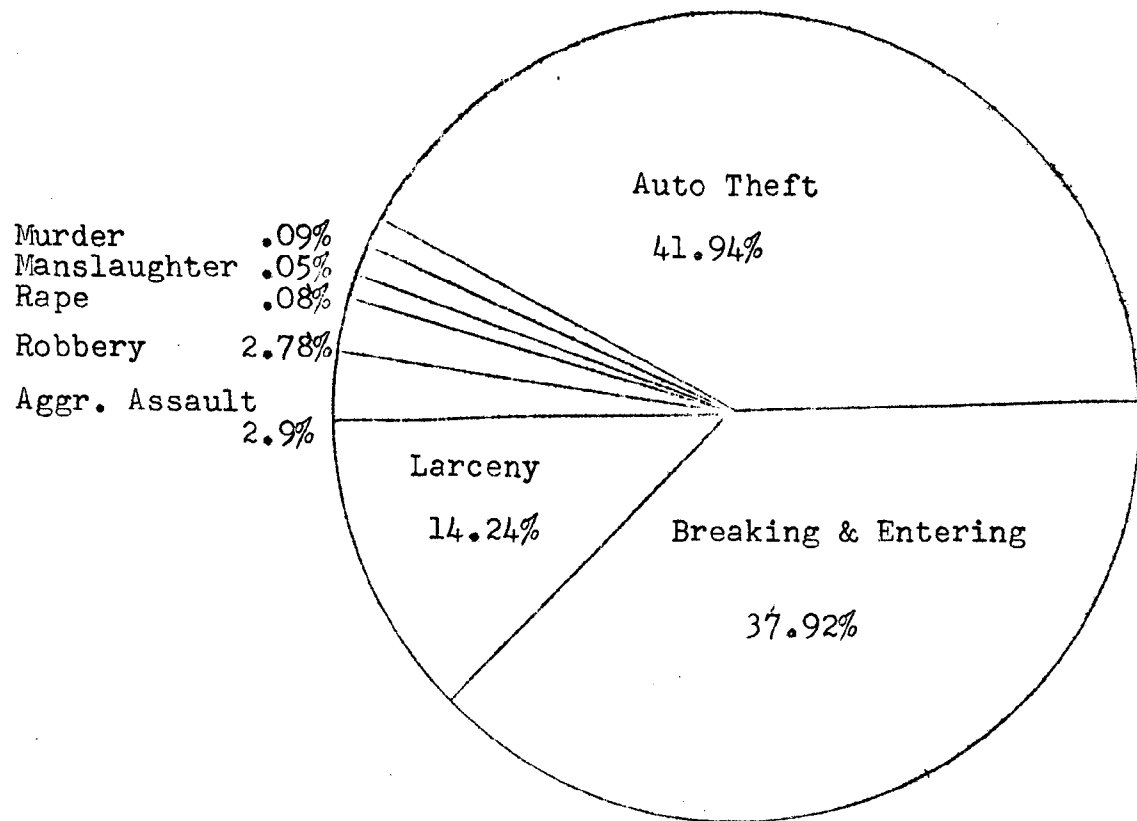

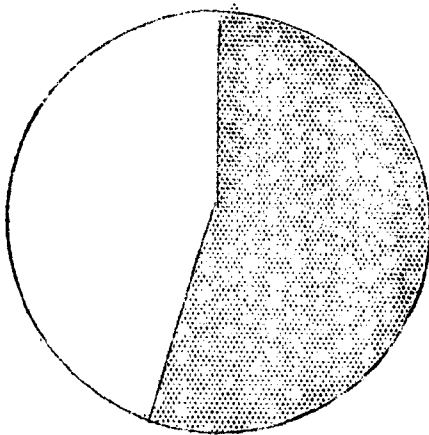

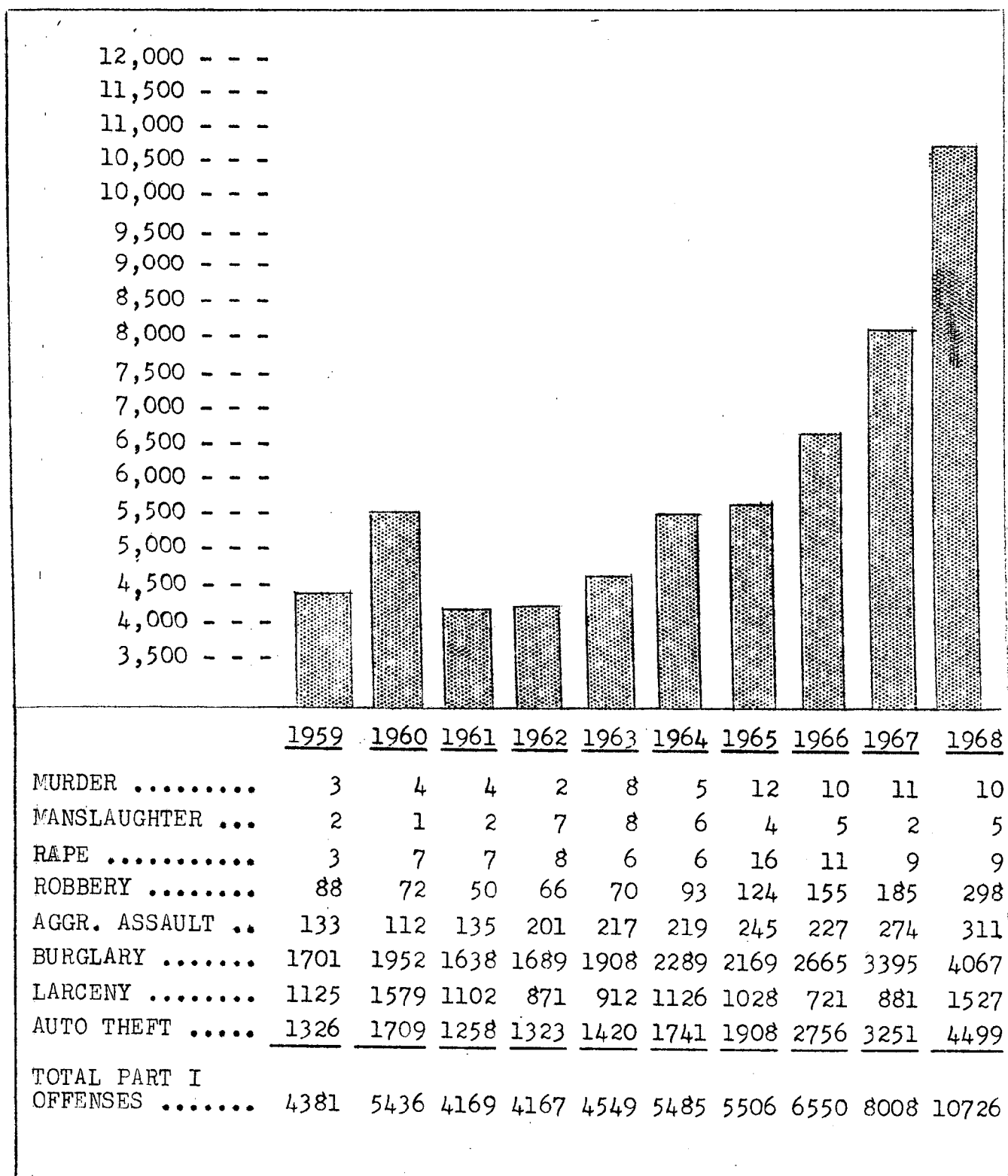

DISTRIBUTION OF 1968 OFFENSES AND CLEARANCES

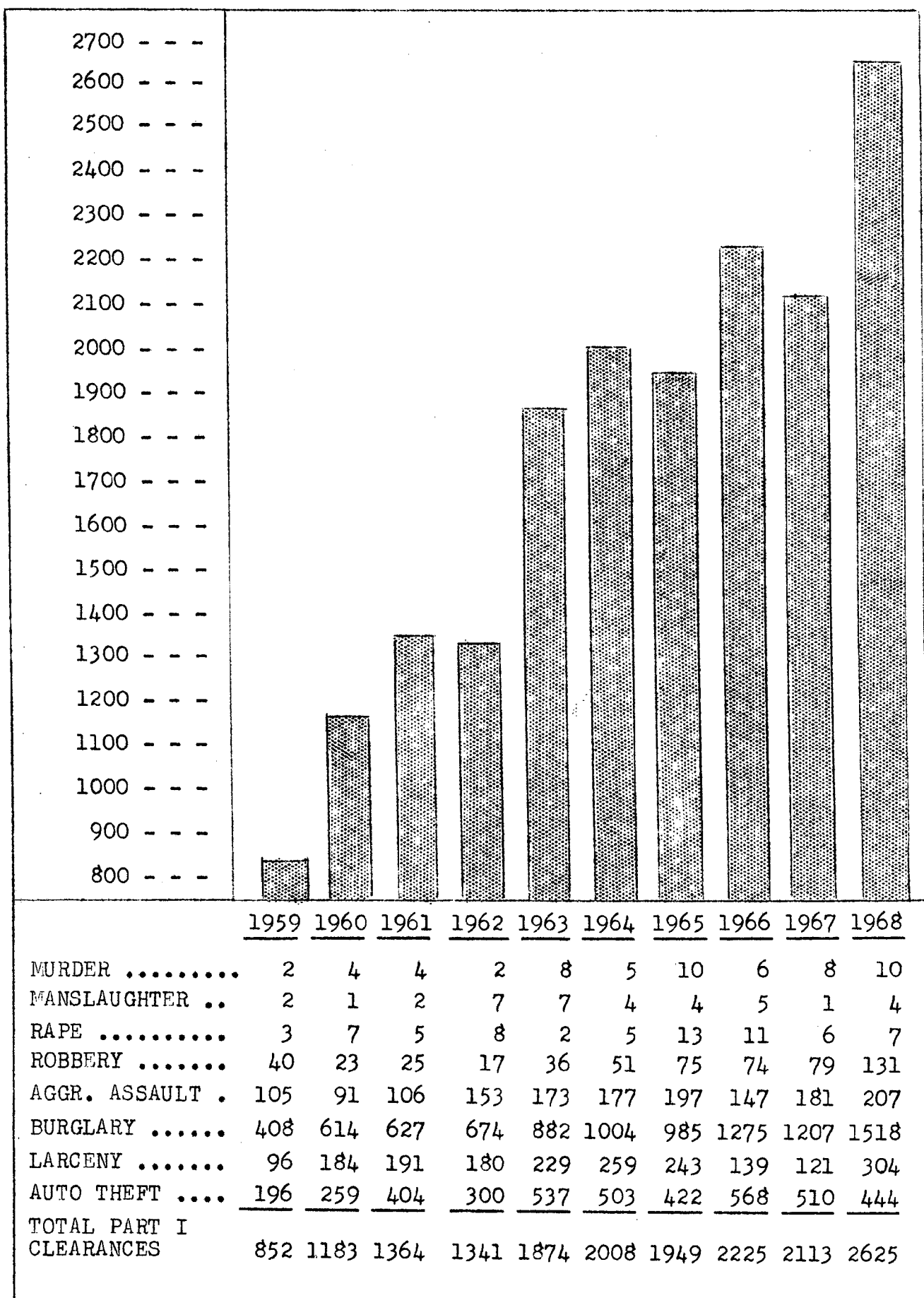

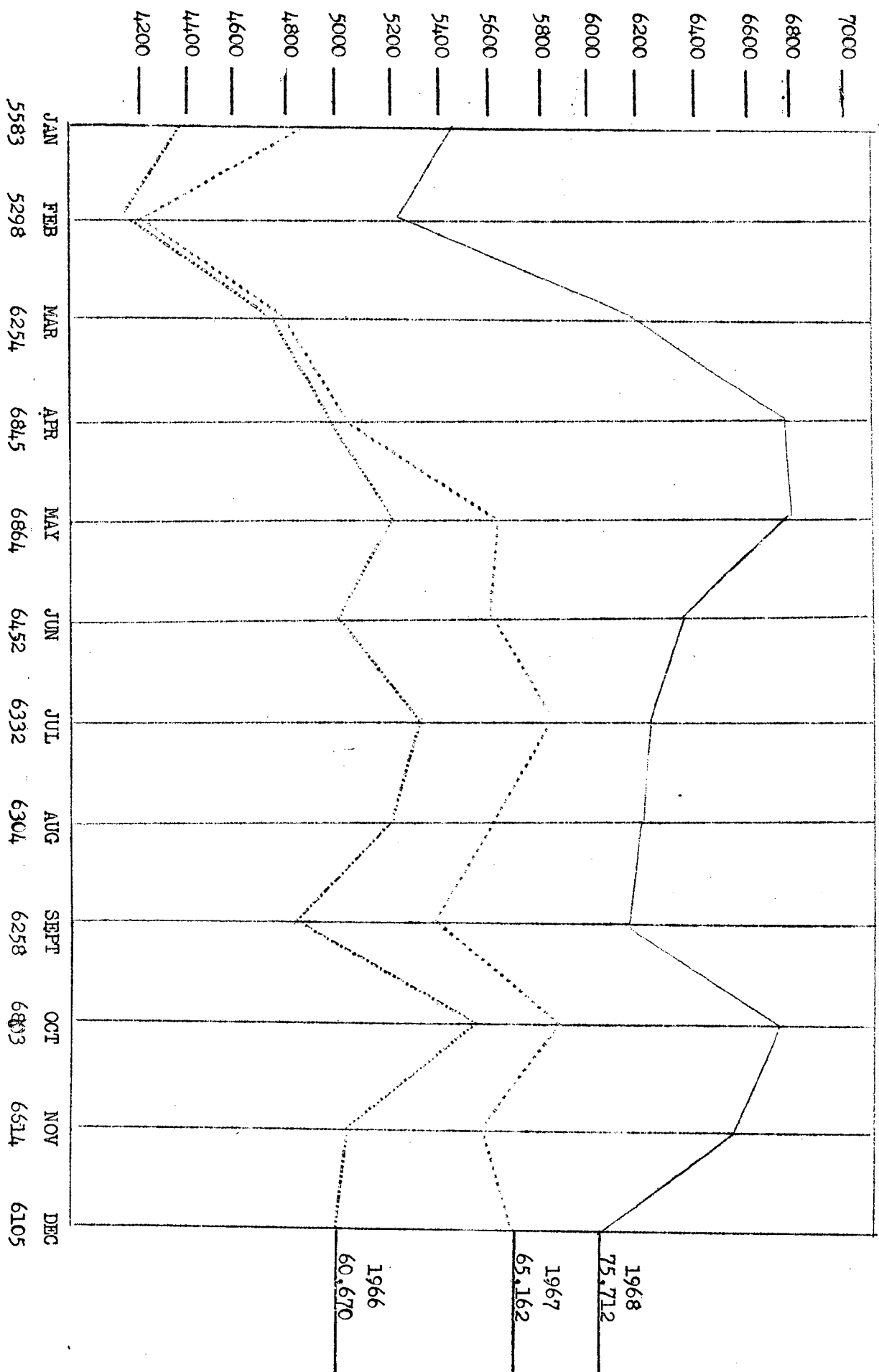
PART I OFFENSES 1959 - 1968

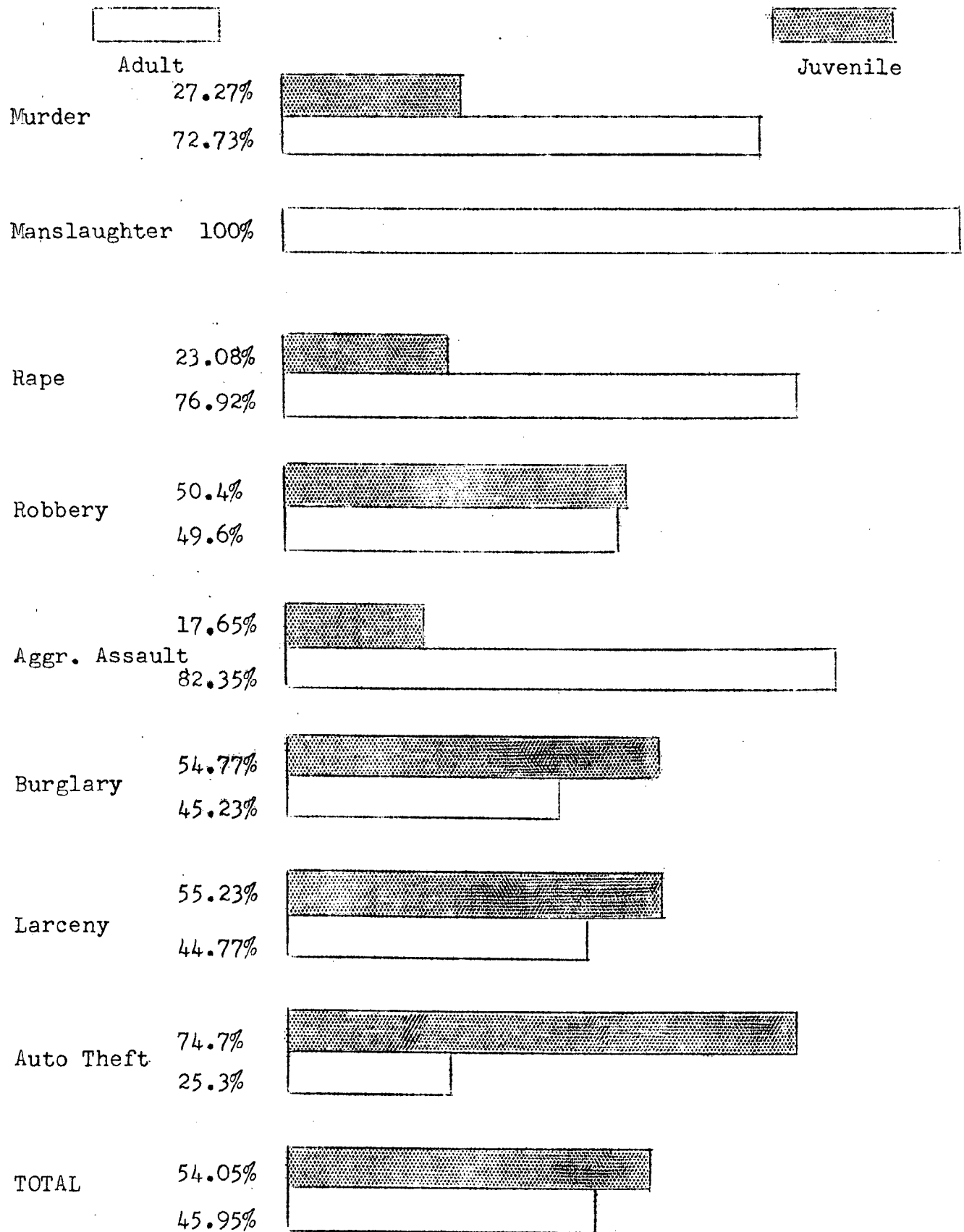

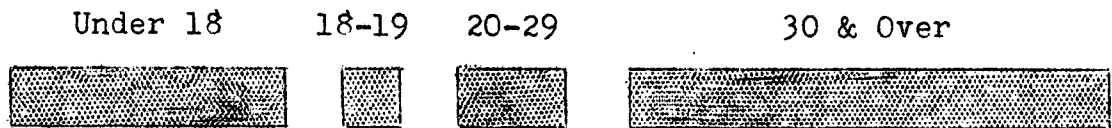
ADULT-JUVENILE ARRESTS FOR PART I OFFENSES IN PROVIDENCE IN 1968



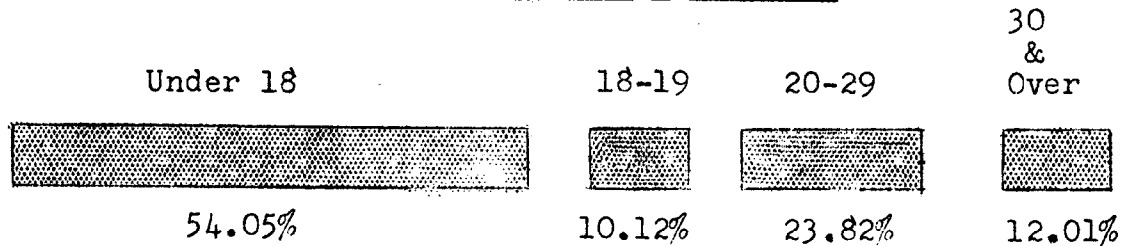
COMPARISON OF POPULATION AGE GROUPS TO ARREST AGE GROUPS

"Special Census of Rhode Island, October, 1965"

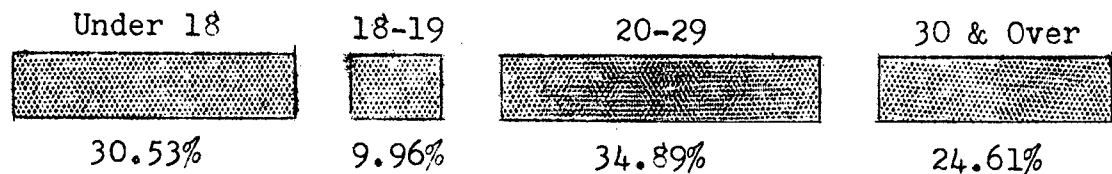
Providence Population by Age Group



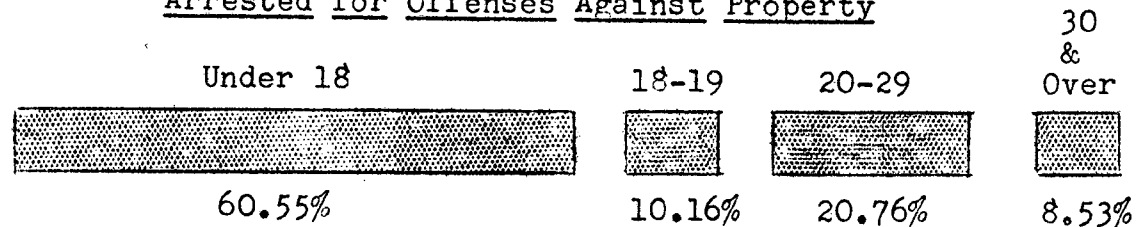
Persons Arrested for Part I Offenses
