The following Ordinances were in City Council August 4, 1983, Read and Passed the First Time and are Returned for Passage the Second Time:

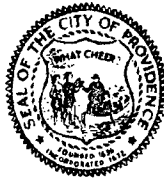
An Ordinance Granting a Tax Exemption of \$3,000 to Owners of Motor Vehicles Equipped for the Handicapped, as Amended.


