RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 617

Approved November 13, 1967

WHEREAS, the former Board of Alderman by Resolution passed June 16, 1932 designated an area at Point and Plain streets as "William A. Kelly Memorial Square" in posthumous tribute to his supreme sacrifice while in action on November 11, 1918, and

WHEREAS, with condemnation for the construction of the route 95 freeway and a service road connector, that area heretofore designates as "William A. Kelly Memorial Square" has been eliminated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the General Assembly is urged to designate and cause an appropriate memorial to be erected upon that area bounded by Point and Plain streets and by Beacon avenue and that it is known as "William A. Kelly Memorial Square", and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Resolution of the former Board of Alderman, passed June 14, 1932 is hereby rescinded.



Approved November 13, 1967

RESOLVED,

That the City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to borrow from time to time such sums as may be necessary, not to exceed FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000) DOLLARS, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 8 of the Public Laws, passed by the General Assembly at its January Session, A.D. 1967, and approved February 23, 1967, entitled "An Act Authorizing the City of Providence to Issue Bonds in the Amount of Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000) Dollars for the Renovatinn, Improvement, Enlargement, and Relocation of Existing Library Buildings and Facilities of the Providence Public Library", and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by him and countersigned by the Mayor and the Chairman of the Finance Committee, and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due. The money thus obtained is hereby appropriated for and shall be exclusively used and expended for the renovation, improvement, enlargement and relocation of the existing library buildings and facilities of the Providence Public Library.
