# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 60

Approved February 17, 1975

WHEREAS, it has been the tradition since the City of Providence elected its first Mayor in 1832, to wait upon encumbent Mayors and request that they sit for official portraits, which portraits now hang in the Chamber of the City Council, in City Hall, Providence, appropriately identified,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a Special Committee of the City Council, consisting of five Members thereof, to be appointed by the President of said City Council, is hereby created for the purpose as here-in-before noted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such sum of money, necessary for the commission of said protrait and appropriate framing, shall be charged to the Appropriation of Contingencies.
