PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE:

1. Chief of Administrative Affairs, Office of the Mayor, City of Providence: January 1975 to present.

Duties include overall responsibility for all departments, boards, commissions, review boards and authorities, whether major or advisory, for the City of Providence, Rhode Island; Population 170,000. Also included is the management of the Chief Executive's staff and chief preparer of the City budget and general fiscal operation of this municipal corporation.

2. City Solicitor, City of Providence, Rhode Island: July 1976 to present.

Responsible for managing seven attorneys for the City of Providence, a \$140 million municipal corporation. Duties include budget, property and casualty decisions dealing with the City as a self-insurer and subrogation against other companies, labor negotiations with seven unions representing management, full responsibility for dealings with the U. S. Government Environmental Protection Agency, OSHA, Dept. of Labor, Concentrated Employment Act, Dept. of Housing and Urban Development, and all other federal programs.

3. Chief of Legal Affairs, Mayor's Office of Community Development: June 1975 to present.

Responsible for managing five attorneys dealing with all legal aspects of Community Development.

4. Chief, Management Team of Mayor's Office of Community Development.

Duties include overall responsibility for the management team of five members which operates this \$27 million dollar, 100% federally-funded program.

5. Deputy City Solicitor, City of Providence, 1965 to June 1974.

Overall responsibility included management of the Law Department of this 86 million dollar per year municipal corporation, including personnel management, office management, research and development.

6. Project Director of Law Enforcement Assistance Administration 1973 - 1974.

Responsibilities included managing and directing a project to streamline and to improve court administration.

7. Attorney for City of Providence, State of Rhode Island 1963 - June 1974.

8. State Chairman, National Institute of Municipal Law Officers, 1974 - 1977.
9. Legal Advisor, Providence Police Department 1966 - 1974.
Establishment of in-service training of police officers and program analysis training.

Responsibilities included liaison work between the Board of Directors and Executive Director and department head of Health Maintenance Organization; overall responsibilities for reviewing construction, personnel, medicare, medicaid and physician liability contracts; budget and development of capitated program.

Responsibilities included teaching and instructing all aspects of law with emphasis on judicial system (i.e., with problems of the poor and federal programming).

Responsibilities included planning, researching and drafting legislation for Rhode Island State Legislature relative to updating the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.
