NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That His Honor, the Mayor, and the Finance Director, are hereby authorized to petition the Director of the Department of Administration of the State of Rhode Island under the provisions of Section 28 of Chapter 329, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1938, as amended, to authorize a tax assessment to be made by the City Council of the City of Providence in excess of the 2½% (two and one-half per cent) of the value of the ratable property of the City, and to present to said Director of the Department of Administration, State of Rhode Island, such evidence as may be necessary with respect to the merits of this petition.
