


WHEREAS, Patricia was one of the co-founders of the Rhode Island Chapter of the One Church One Child Program, which has become a National Organization for needy children, and

WHEREAS, at an early age Patricia was called upon once again, but this time to preach and sing the words of the gospel, which she has been doing for a long time,

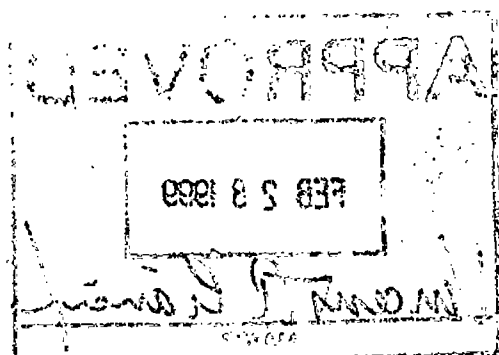
