2. The Department of Public Works has been working with the Administration to evaluate options to improve bulky collection. We welcome any input from this Committee. The process as agreed to in the contract with Waste Management works well if the constituent calls Waste Management. The Department is working to educate the public through various outreach programs with the assistance of Waste Management and the RIRRC.
3.	Resolution Requesting the Acting Director of Public Works to cause the re-pavement of Academy Avenue between Chalkstone Avenue and Atwells Avenue in the Road Improvement Program.	This section of roadway has a Pavement Condition Index equal to 58, on a scale of 0 to 100. The Highway will excavate a test pit of the road at certain locations of the road to allow better evaluation of the issues that are causing the pavement to deteriorate prematurely.
