
Gentlemen:


Gentlemen:

In view of the existing satisfactory operation, we do not recommend the installation of traffic control signs at this time.



Gentlemen:

In response to the subject resolution, the Providence Redevelopment Agency has completed an evaluation of the proposal by the City Council to provide fencing along the northerly property line of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad in the Mashapaug Redevelopment Project for protection against injury to the general public.

We concur that there exists an exposure of hazard to the life and safety of the public. Therefore, we have begun steps to provide protection. Plans and contract documents have been prepared and advertising commenced to contract with the lowest qualified bidder for the erection of a fence between Cranston Street to the fencing in the first private ownership on Huntington Avenue approximately 3300 feet to the east of Cranston Street.

This development will commence as soon as weather conditions permit. However, it is pointed out to the Honorable City Council that although the subject fence will act as a deterrent, it will not prevent a person who is determined to trespass this boundary nor is it ever reasonably prevented.

The Agency is pleased to work this solution out with the City Council and we seize upon this opportunity to publicly acknowledge our appreciation for the extensive cooperation provided to us by the City Council in the urban renewal program of Providence.
