It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 12-20 of the General Laws entitled "Costs" is
2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
3 12-20-7.1. Costs of police witnesses. -- The court shall assess
4 as court costs in addition, to those otherwise provided by law,
5 against all defendants charged with a felony, misdemeanor or petty
6 misdemeanor, and who plead nolo contendere, guilty or who are found
7 guilty of the commission of such crimes, the cost of police witnesses.
8 All revenue collected under this section shall be deposited with the
9 city or town as reimbursement of the cost of police witnesses.
10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
