

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved February 24, 1970

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED

THAT the portion of Roger Williams Avenue, from Narragansett Avenue to its easterly termination, and that portion of Burrows Street, from Roger Williams Avenue to its northerly termination, shown as cross-hatched area and designated by the letters A-B-C-D-E-F-G-A on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R. I., P. W. Dept.-Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Plan No. 063232, Date October 15, 1968", has ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on ~~that portion of Roger Williams Avenue, from Narragansett Avenue to its easterly termination, and that portion of Burrows Street, from Roger Williams Avenue to its northerly termination,~~ abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting ~~that portion of Roger Williams Avenue, from Narragansett Avenue to its easterly termination, and that portion of Burrows Street, from Roger Williams Avenue to its northerly termination,~~ which has been abandoned, who is known to reside withi this state.





Dear Councilman Payne:

On August 26, we received a memorandum dated August 20 from the Department of the City Clerk together with a copy of a resolution for the abandonment of a portion of Roger Williams Avenue. After reviewing this resolution and a print from the Department of Public Works, we find that our facilities in the section to be abandoned will have to be removed and relocated within the new street alignment in order to maintain our present continuity of water main installation.

The cost of removing and relocating the 8" cast iron main with its pertinent facilities will cost the department \$2,005.00. It is indicated that the abandonment is at the request of Hi Hat Food Products Company, and we respectfully request that your Committee take no action on this matter until the Hi Hat Food Products Company compensates the department in the amount of \$2,005.00. We are filing a bill in the City Clerk's Office in the above amount and will notify the Public Works Department when payment is received covering the cost of relocating the above mentioned water facilities.

Also, included in this memorandum for abandonment were Hauxhurst Street and Brookfield Street in which the Water Supply Board has no facilities.

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works seeks the abandonment of a portion of what was once Roger Williams Ave., part of Burrows Street and a parcel of land condemned for the new Roger Williams Avenue but not presently in use, as shown on the accompanying diagram.


On an inspection and photographic survey, it was determined that the land proposed for abandonment is no longer being used as a public highway and is vacant and unimproved. It is bounded by the railroad on the east, by the Hi Hat Food Products Company on the north and by the paved portion of Roger Williams Avenue on the south. The neighborhood is mixed industrial, commercial and residential and in fair to good condition.

Attention is directed to Referral No. 1692 dated 9-12-68 by which the same petitioner requested the same abandonment. After receiving an opinion from the City Solicitor, the Commission voted to grant this petition and since there have been no discernable changes since that time,






