An Ordinance in Amendment of and in Addition to Chapter 1982-54 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, Approved September 10, 1982, and entitled: "An Ordinance Establishing a Special Development District in the City of Providence and Designating the Capital Center Commission, a Commission created by the Rhode Island General Assembly, as a Public Body of the City of Providence to Adopt, Implement and Administer a Plan of Development for such Special Development District Pursuant to Sections 45-24.4 Et. Seq. 'Rhode Island Special Development District Enabling Act'."

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. That Chapter 1982-54, Ordinance No. 493, approved September 10, 1982, and entitled:

"An Ordinance Establishing a Special Development District in the City of Providence and Designating the Capital Center Commission, a Commission created by the Rhode Island General Assembly, as a Public Body of the City of Providence to Adopt, Implement and Administer a Plan of Development for such Special Development District Pursuant to Sections 45-24.4 et seq. 'Rhode Island Special Development District Enabling Act' " be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

A. the Description of the Special Development district set forth in Article II is hereby amended to add the contiguous area generally bounded by Hayes Street, Francis Street, Gaspee Street, Promenade Street, and Interstate Route 95 and is more particularly described in Exhibit B attached hereto.

Section 2. That said Chapter 1982-54 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence as adopted and as heretofore amended, be and the same is hereby ratified and affirmed in all other respects.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect on its passage and shall be filed with the City Clerk who is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy thereof to the Capital Center Commission.
