
WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Public Works is requested to present to the City Council Committee on Public Works the plan for rodent control in the City of Providence.


WHEREAS, The director is hereby requested to furnish the following information as part of the city's rodent control program:

- The method that exists for resident response to complaints of rodent activity.
- The equipment, materials, personnel utilized in the rodent control program.
- An inventory of resident complaints associated with rodent control.
- A performance report on the rodent control program for the preceding twenty four (24) months.

WHEREAS, This Resolution establishes the assumption that a rodent control program is currently a part of the department's neighborhood services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That absent any rodent control program, this resolution shall represent the City Council's formal request that such a program be established and that the program be presented to City Council through its Committee on Public Works no later than May 1, 2000.
