Approved April 29, 1978

WHEREAS, Presiding Justice Joseph R. Weisberger of the Superior Court was elected as Associate Justice of the Rhode Island Supreme Court by a joint session of the General Assembly on February 24, 1978, and

WHEREAS, Sworn into that office on March 10, 1978 by Governor J. Joseph Garrahy, he was characterized as one of the most distinguished trial judges in the United States, and
