

WHEREAS, Section 3.1 of the Charter of the City of Providence directs that in the first year following the report of the federal decennial census, the City Council shall by Ordinance and with General Assembly approval, alter the boundaries of the thirteen (13) Wards of the City, if need be, in such manner as will as nearly as possible result in compact, contiguous wards of substantially equal population as determined by the aforesaid census, and

WHEREAS, The administration of the City of Providence, in accepting that directive, is preparing to pursue the necessary remedy as outlined by said Charter,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the President of the City Council is hereby authorized to create a Special Committee for the Purpose of Studying and Reporting Back to Said City Council, the Reapportionment and the Redistricting of all Wards in the City of Providence.
