
The information requested by you in a memorandum dated August 17, is as follows:

Appian Street, Corina Street to Hawkins Street
Blaine Street, Ledge Street to Bismark Street
Coggeshall Street, Douglas Avenue to Mowry Street
Corina Street, " " to Appian Street
Herschel Street, Manton Avenue to Bel Air Drive
Lavaughn Street, Amherst Street to Atwells Avenue
Mowry Street, Douglas Avenue to Admiral Street
Ventura Street, Huxley Avenue to Dante Street

During a recent road surface evaluating survey it was noted that the above herein mentioned streets were characterized as very bad, the status of which has not changed.

Burton Street which has two houses and one (1) garage, extends to Wild Street. The first one hundred and fifty (150) ft. running southerly from Carder Street could be resurfaced without any grading difficulty. Would recommend for surfacing- Caxton Street, which extends from Wild Street to Veazie Street, services one (1) two (2) car garage, three (3) parking areas for auto spaces, one (1) parking area for two (2) auto spaces while servicing two (2) driveways leading into properties belonging to two (2) separate contractors. Said street does present grade problems at its extremities. The surfacing of this street requires signed releases from abutting owners.


