RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 153

Approved March 19, 1973

WHEREAS, His Excellency Philip W. Noel, Governor of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations, did appoint former City Solicitor Robert J. McOsker, as an Associate Justice of the Rhode Island District Court, and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the State of Rhode Island did confirm his appointment, and

WHEREAS, Governor Noel administered the Oath of Office to Judge-Designate Robert J. McOsker on March 5, 1973, thus qualifying him to sit as a member of that distinguished Judicial Tribunal in and for the State of Rhode Island, and

WHEREAS, Judge Robert J. McOsker, whose experience as a practicing attorney in this State, his public career as a member of the City Council and as the City Solicitor of the Capital City of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations provided a background which eminently qualified him for appointment as a member of the Judiciary, and

Doorley, Jr., the Members of the City Council of the City of Providence, and the several Department Heads and Administrative Staff of the City Government do hereby congratulate him upon this important milestone in his young life and express the wish that he and his family continue to receive God's choicest blessings and that he be granted sage and fair judgment in his future Judicial deliberations.
