

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 439

Approved August 10, 2001

WHEREAS, the City of Providence is committed to developing the Woonasquatucket River Greenway as a vehicle for increased recreation, transportation and an improved urban environment;

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved the expenditure of \$2.9 million dollars of Neighborhood Improvement Bond Funds for the development of the Woonasquatucket River Greenway;

WHEREAS, the Providence Redevelopment Agency passed Resolution No. 9488 on October 8, 1998 stating that the Riverside Mills and Lincoln Lace and Braid properties are needed for revitalization activities as part of the Woonasquatucket River Greenway development;

WHEREAS it is the intention of the Providence City Council to convey the Riverside Mills property (Plat 63 Lots 435, 344 & 326) and the Lincoln Lace and Braid property (Plat 113 Lots 305 & 429) to the Providence Redevelopment Authority for the interim period of the development of the Woonasquatucket River Greenway and that it is in the best interest of the City of Providence and the surrounding neighborhoods to do so;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That deeds be executed to transfer such properties to the Providence Redevelopment Agency and that the Providence Redevelopment Agency shall see that said property is developed in accordance with the Woonasquatucket River Greenway Master Plan, Providence 2000: The Comprehensive Plan and the City of Providence Zoning Ordinance;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, including deeds, relative to the conveyance of said parcels.
