

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 362

Approved June 16, 2000

WHEREAS, It has been brought to the attention of the City Council that the ornamental street lighting system of the City (the "ornamental street lighting system") is in need of substantial renovations and repairs; and

WHEREAS, the street lighting system is comprised of various makes and models of ornamental street lights; and

WHEREAS, due to the number of makes and models it is financially impracticable for the City to maintain in stock replacement parts for the various street lights; and

WHEREAS, as a result, street lights in the City are out of service from time to time while replacement parts are ordered; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of public health and safety, it is in the best interest of the City to provide for a mechanism to ensure the timely repair and replacement of the ornamental street lighting system; and

WHEREAS, the City's Board of Contract and Supply is soliciting proposals for the purchase by a vendor of the City's ornamental street lighting system and the maintenance of the ornamental street lighting system by such a vendor; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Contract and Supply has given public notice of the sale of the ornamental street lighting system, and

WHEREAS, the City Assessor has caused an appraisal of the ornamental street lighting system to be performed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

1. The City Council hereby approves the transfer of the title and interest of the City in the ornamental street lighting system to the vendor selected by the Board of Contract and Supply pursuant to its competitive bidding process by manner of sale lease-purchase. The City Council reserves the right to restrict the affixing of any material, printed, electrical, cellular or otherwise, to any and all of the decorative lights included in this transfer.
2. The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a lease-purchase and maintenance agreement with the vendor, and the Mayor is authorized to take any and all action and to execute, file and deliver the lease-purchase maintenance agreement and any and all other agreements, notes and other documents in such form as he may deem necessary or desirable to implement the lease-purchase financing and maintenance of the ornamental street lighting system.
3. The Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
