requested to afford Lt. Calcagni a speedy trial.

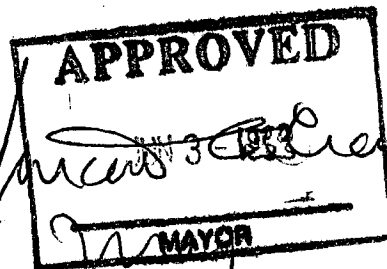
