No. 354 **AN ORDINANCE** ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT OF
DOGS TO BE KEPT BY THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT OF A DWELLING HOUSE

Approved June 8, 1977

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Sec. 4-37.1 is hereby added to the Ordinances of the City of Providence establishing the amount of dogs to be kept by the owner or occupant of a dwelling house, and reads as follows:

"Sec. 4-37.1. That no owner or occupant of any dwelling house shall keep or permit to be kept more than three (3) dogs in any part of any dwelling house except if said owner or occupant complies with Sec. 4-13-10 of the Rhode Island General Laws, 1956, as amended."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by the City Council and approved by the Mayor.
