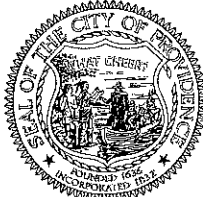

Dear Chairman Igliazzi (and Finance Committee members):

At tonight's hearing, the Finance Committee will review the Mayor's nomination of Harrison (Harry) Bilodeau to serve another term on the City Plan Commission. I write to express my strong support for Mr. Bilodeau and to ask you and the members of the Finance Committee to vote to approve his nomination at tonight's meeting.

Mr. Bilodeau brings a valuable background and skill set to the City Plan Commission. He is the President of Bilodeau Properties, a successful property management company he established 30 years ago. His resume describes his extensive involvement in the local real estate market through service on trade associations and committees. Mr. Bilodeau also has been active in the community, among other things sponsoring for many years a Little League team (known in my son's day as the Bilodeau Bombers) that has brought great joy and life experience to scores of children.

I consider him to be the ideal public servant, and I hope you all will see fit to recommend his return for continued service on this important commission. Thank you for your consideration.

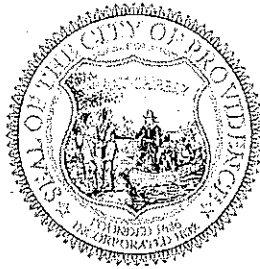
