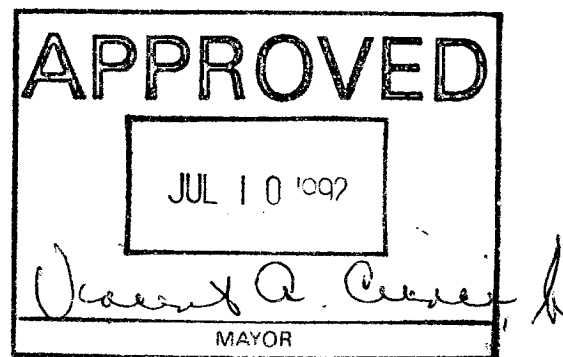
RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
