No. 310 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING SECTIONS 60, 61, 62, and 63 OF CHAPTER 1982-44 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED JULY 7, 1982, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS" AND REPEALING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1981-40, EFFECTIVE JULY 20, 1981 RELATIVE TO WATER SUPPLY BOARD.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Sections 60, 61, 62, and 63 of Chapter 1982-44 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved July 7, 1982, is hereby amended as follows:
