




The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to undertake a survey of all residential streets within the Washington Park Section, so-called, for the purpose of designating specifically, heavy truck routes; said residential streets that may be designated specifically as heavy turck routes, shall not exclude local deliveries.

Disposition: This department requests that the Councilmen in the area obtain a list from their constituents as to what streets are being heavily travelled. Such a survey, if undertaken by this department, would require an additional work force and would entail hundreds of man hours.
