Be advised that I recommend that Roanoke Street be established as a one-way street in an easterly direction between Leah Street and Mt. Pleasant Avenue. This request by George J. West Middle School is warranted as it will promote safety for school busses and parents dropping off and picking up school children by ensuring the children exit and enter vehicles on the school side rather than on the curb-side opposite the school thus forcing children to cross opposing (on-coming) traffic on this narrow street. The few (five) property owners on this street concur with our recommendation.

Also, be advised that I recommend that Princeton Avenue be established as a one-way street in an easterly direction between Bucklin Street and Elmwood Avenue. Similar to the above case, it will promote school safety by having busses and parents drop off and pick up children on the school curbside. The one-way street will also improve the school circulation pattern on this narrow congested street with vehicles entering the area at the Daboll Street traffic signal.
