

2. The first curb return on both the Broad Street and Somerset Street frontages is less than 20 feet at the point of intersection of the two curb lines.
3. The plan does not indicate any provisions being made for drainage of the paved lot area.

Fate of Trinity Sq. Cafe Is Hanging in the Balance

Will the words "Fill 'er up" be addressed to a filling station attendant or to a bartender at the Broad Street location where a cafe has been operated by the same owners since prohibition was repealed.

That question was raised yesterday afternoon at an emotion-charged public hearing before the Providence City Council license committee. The committee postponed decision pending further study.

Specifically under consideration was an application of the Atlantic Refining Co. for permission to enlarge a gasoline station at Broad and Somerset Streets by installing additional underground storage tanks.

As part of the expansion plan, two adjoining buildings, one of them housing a neighborhood landmark—the Trinity Square Cafe at 348-350 Broad St.—are scheduled to be razed.

Objections to the granting of the permit were presented on behalf of Martin Derderian, owner of property at 340-346 Broad St., and the Laurel Corp., which operates a professional office building at 369-371 Broad St., on

the grounds that their buildings would become less desirable to prospective tenants.

John G. Coffey who represented the oil company, asserted that the objections were irrelevant to the narrow question of a permit for gasoline storage that was the only matter properly before the committee.

The public hearing had moved to other matters and was about to be adjourned when a woman in the City Council chamber was asked if she wished to address the committee.

Indeed she did, replied the woman, who identified herself as Mrs. Juliette M. Sullivan.

Her interest, she explained, involved the future, if any, of the family business—the cafe operated by her husband, Thomas, and brother-in-law, Cornelius Sullivan, for the past 25 years.

During all that time, she said, the Sullivan brothers had repaired and maintained the cafe premises at their own expense. They had installed a modern front and, as tenants, had spent substantial sums above the amount of rent paid under

terms of their lease, she went on.

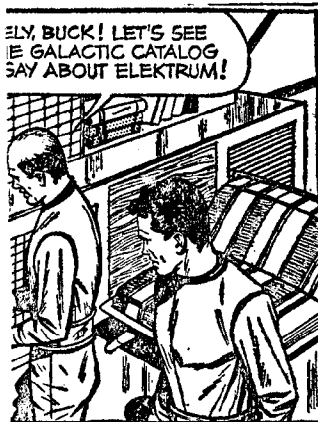
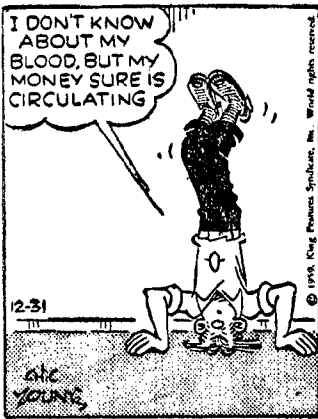
Mrs. Sullivan said this was done as the result of an understanding with the prior owner, who is now dead, that if the building were ever to be sold, it would be offered first of all to the Sullivans.

That pledge was forgotten, she said, when the daughter and son-in-law of the former owner agreed to sell the building to the oil company. She said the family wants desperately to be able to continue operating the family business at its present location. If dispossessed, she said, the brothers are too old to find other employment and would have scant hope of relocating the cafe successfully.

Mr. Derderian, who had retained legal counsel to present his objections, spoke up in behalf of his neighbors, the Sullivans.

It would be, he said, neither right nor fair—in fact "really a shame"—to allow expansion of a gasoline station to injure the Sullivans — "people who had never harmed anyone."
